

Border Text Tutorial

Using small words as a border serves a dual purpose - you can convey a sentiment and it adds an interesting twist to the piece. Filmed by Beth Norman.

Finished Card:

Artist: Beth Norman
Stamps: Magnetic Poetry;
Impression Obsession



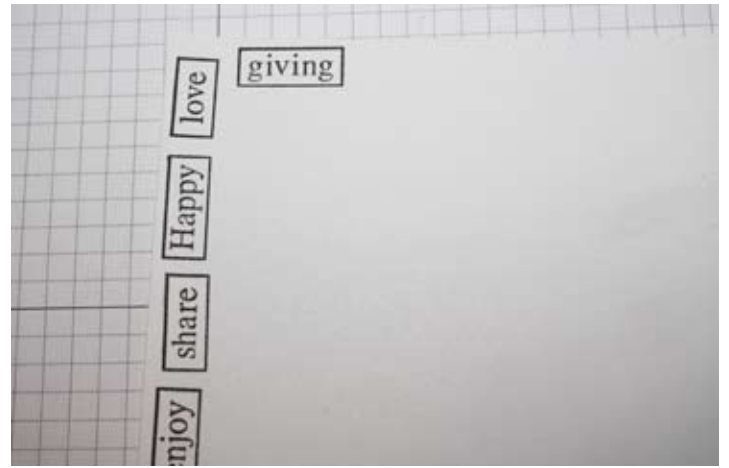
Supplies:

- Small Word Stamps
- Cardstock
- Focal Image Stamp
- Ink



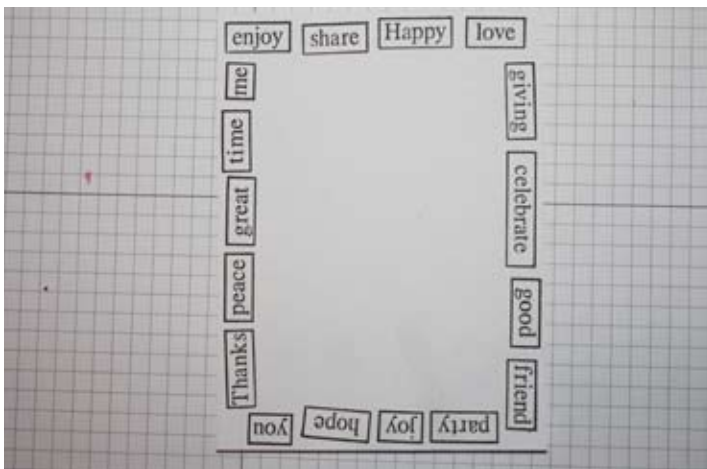
Step One:

Stamp first word horizontally in upper left corner of cardstock as close to the top as possible.



Step Two:

Stamp along the entire top edge. Turn card 90° and continue stamping words along the “new” top edge.



Step Three:

Continue stamping each edge and turning the cardstock until the four edges are filled with words.



Step Four:

Stamp the focal image in the center of the piece. Color focal image and finish as desired.

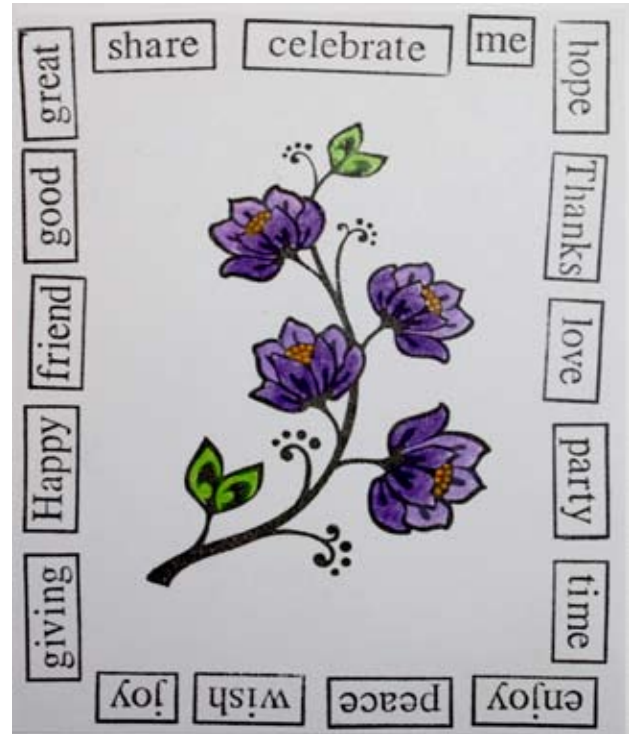

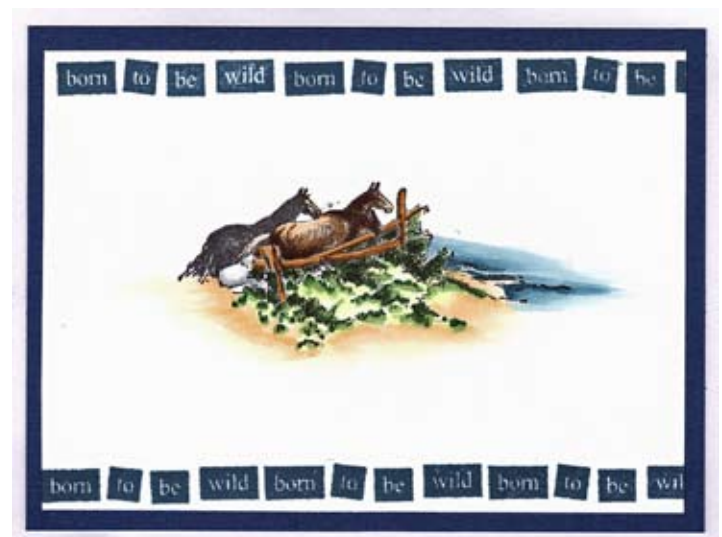

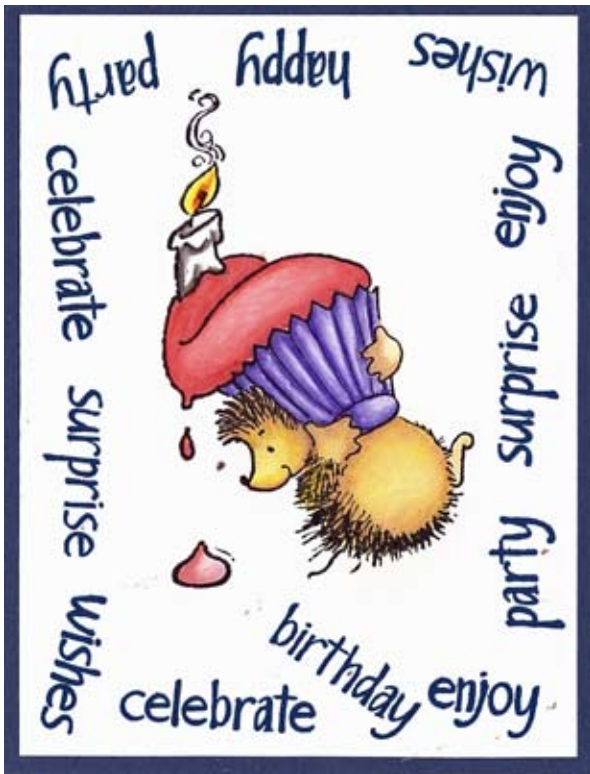
