Finished Card:

Artist: Jane Bosi
Stamps: Technique Junkie Stamps, Amuse



Supplies:

- Background Stamp with open line art images
- White Cardstock
- Black Cardstock
- White Craft Ink
- Black Ink
- Coloring Medium
- White Embossing Powder
- Heat Tool
- Embossing Buddy
- Scissors
- Dimensional Tape



Step One:

Prepare black cardstock with embossing buddy.



Step Two:

Ink background stamp with white craft ink.



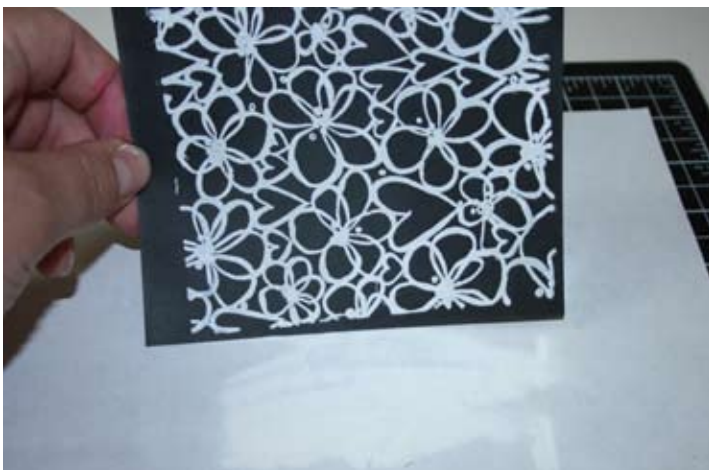
Step Three:

Stamp image onto black cardstock.



Step Four:

Apply white embossing powder to stamped image.



Step Five:

Remove excess embossing powder and emboss with heat tool.



Step Five Continued



Step Six:

Clean stamp.



Step Seven:

Ink background with black ink.



Step Eight:

Stamp image onto white cardstock and allow to dry.



Step Nine:

Select several areas of stamped image to color with medium of choice.



Step Ten:

Using scissors, trim colored images.



Step Eleven:

Pop colored images, using dimensional tape, on top of the embossed images on the black cardstock.



Step Twelve:

Use as desired.

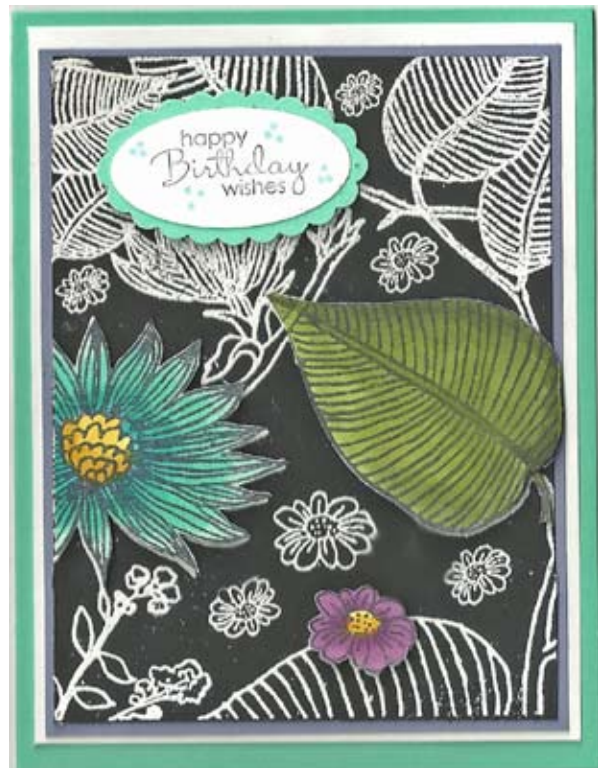
