This double coloring method is great on most background images, but works especially well on negative-style images. Filmed by Jane Bosi.

Finished Card:

Artist: Jane Bosi
Stamps: Technique Junkies Stamps



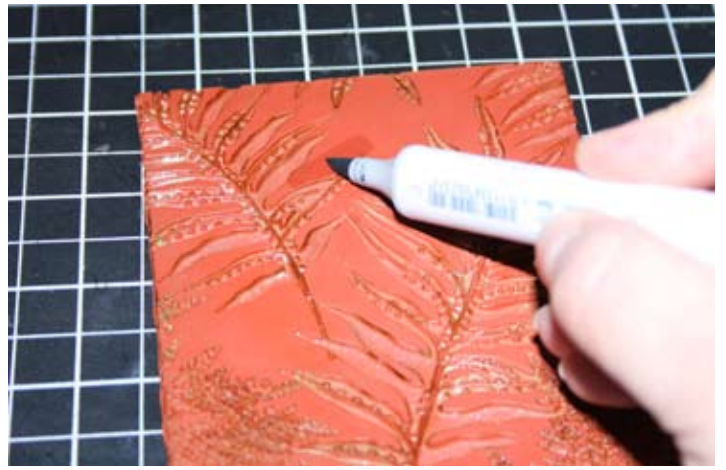
Supplies:

- Background Stamp with Open Images
- Neutral Cardstock for use with Copic Markers
- Copic Colorless Blending Solution
- Spritzer
- Copic Markers



Step One:

Fill spritzer with blending solution.



Step Two:

Using a Copic marker, color directly to stamp surface. Color entire stamp.

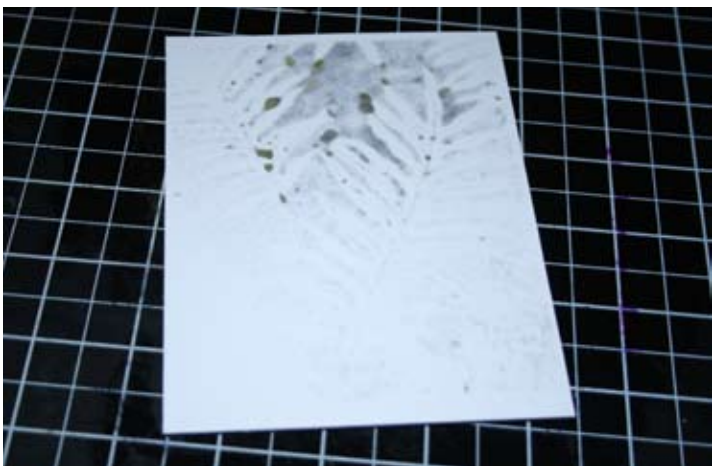


Step Two Continued



Step Three:

Working quickly, spritzer stamp surface with blending solution to reactivate ink.



Step Four:

Immediately cover image with cardstock, by placing it on top of the stamp, to transfer image.

Step Five:

Using Copic markers, color in all white spaces on image.
