

## Distressed Fingerpainting Tutorial

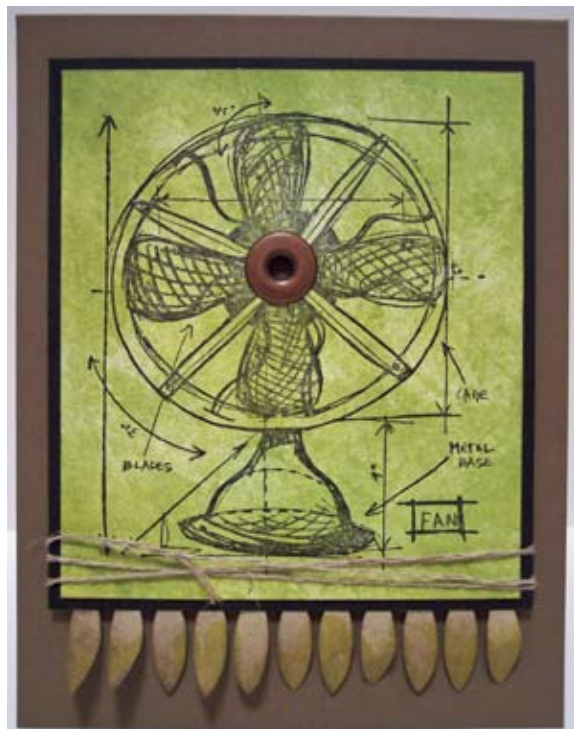
*A little messy - but multi-colored fingers are the sign of a creative artist!*

### Finished Card:

Artist: Holly Brown

Stamps: Stampers Anonymous



### Supplies:

- 2-3 Distress Paints
- Mister/Spray Bottle filled with Water
- Smooth White Cardstock
- Tissue or Paper Towel
- Nonstick Craft Mat
- Surgical Glove, optional (not pictured)



### Step One:

Spray the tissue or paper towel with water and set aside.



### Step Three:

Mist the paint with water.



### Step Five:

Continue dipping fingers into paint and rubbing onto the cardstock until the entire piece is painted.



### Step Two:

Shake the bottles of distress paint. Squeeze out some paint by tapping the sponge applicator onto the craft mat.



### Step Four:

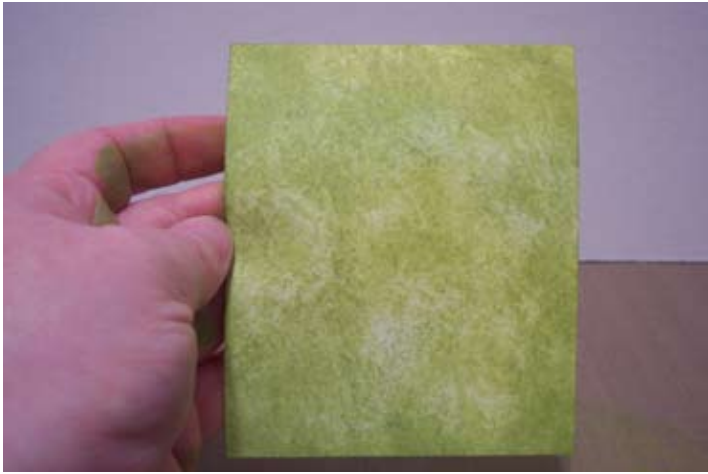
If desired, put surgical glove onto hand. Dip fingers into the paint and rub onto the smooth white cardstock.



### Step Six:

While the paint is still wet, dab the wet tissue/paper towel over the painted cardstock. Work quickly because the paint dries fast. Once the paint is dry, it will not react with water.





### Step Seven:

Let piece dry completely and then use as desired.

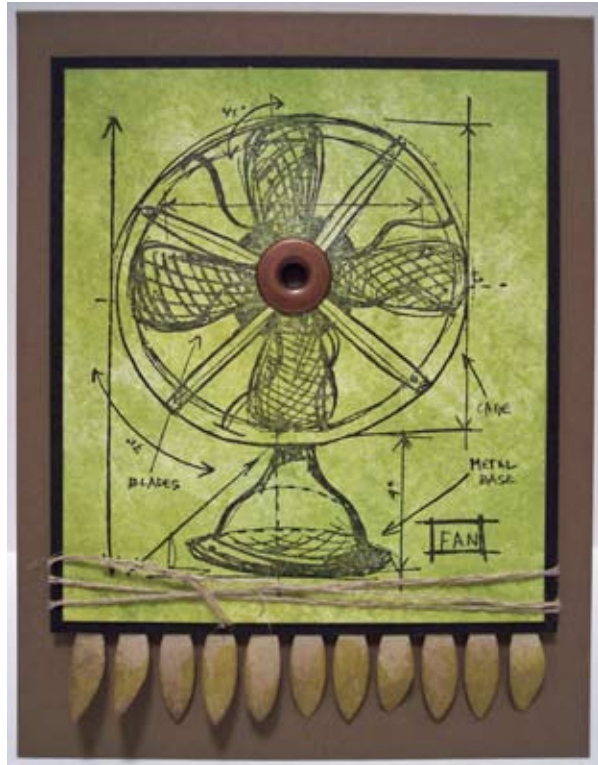

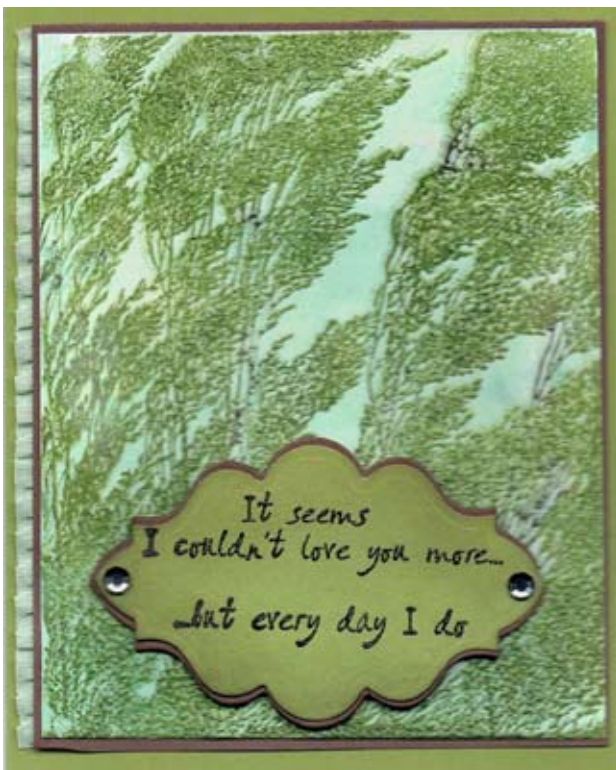
