Finished Card:

Artist: Pat Huntoon

Stamps: Technique Junkies Stamps



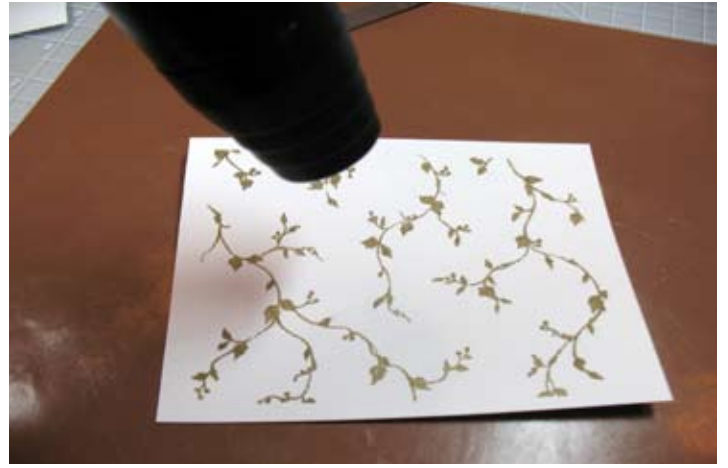
Supplies:

- Background or other Stamp with large open areas
- Gold Pigment Ink Pad, Such a Delicata
- Silver Pigment Ink Pad Such as Delicata
- Heat Tool
- Gold Embossing Powder
- Clear Detail Embossing Powder
- White Cardstock
- Paper Towel



Step One:

Stamp the image on the cardstock with the gold ink.



Step Two:

Cover with gold embossing powder, remove excess, and heat emboss.



Step Three:

Allow the embossed image to cool.



Step Four:

Apply the Silver Delicata ink pad directly over the white embossed cardstock.



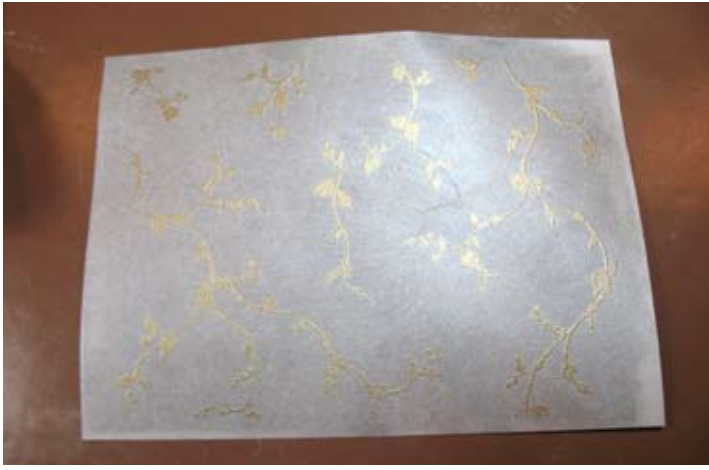
Step Five:

Get full coverage over all the white and embossed areas.



Step Six:

Use the paper towel to remove the silver ink from the embossed image(s). Some of the ink from the background will be removed also.

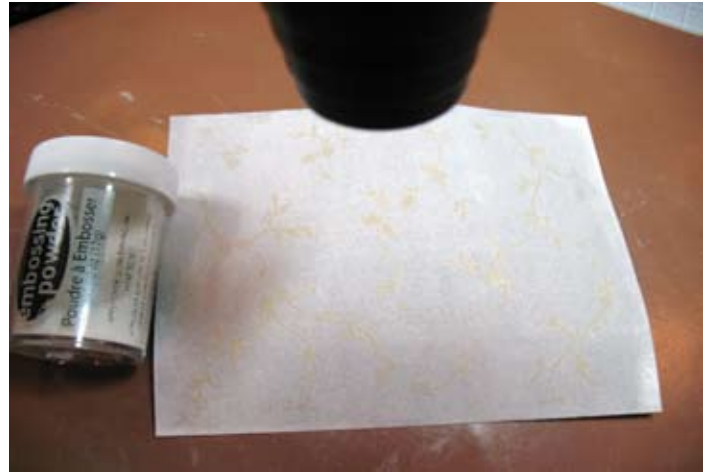


Step Six Continued

Use as desired.



Step Seven:

Cover the piece with the clear detail embossing powder and heat emboss.
