

## Twined Words Tutorial

*This is a fun way to add a message - spelled out in Baker's Twine! Filmed by Holly Brown.*

### Finished Card:

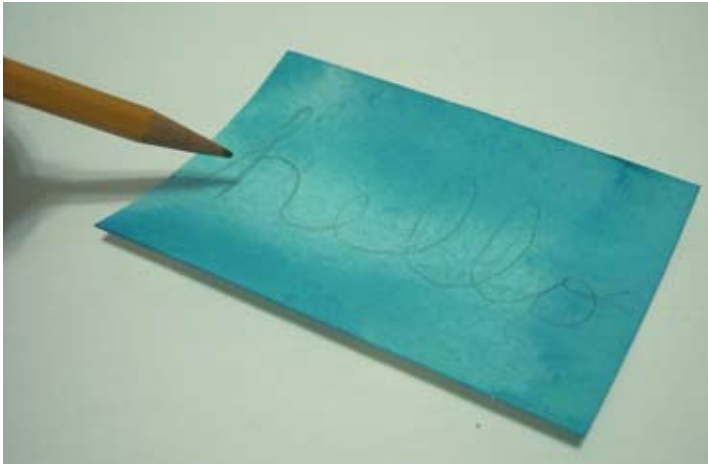
Artist: Holly Brown

Background Technique: Distress Stain Pounce



### Supplies:

- Twine
- Clear Drying Glue
- Scissors
- Pencil
- Decorated Cardstock, Designer Papers, or Technique Backgrounds *\*(Distress Stain Pounce Technique was used on the blue piece)*



### Step One:

Lightly write word(s) onto cardstock with the pencil.



### Step Three:

Lay the twine over the line of glue, tracing the letters. Apply additional dots of glue as needed when twine overlaps.



### Step Five:

Use the scissors to cut the twine at the end of the word(s).  
Use piece as desired.



### Step Two:

Squeeze the clear drying glue over the penciled word(s), only tracing one or two letters at a time. NOTE: Aim for a thin line of glue. The amount used in this picture is too thick - this was intentionally done for the purpose of this tutorial.



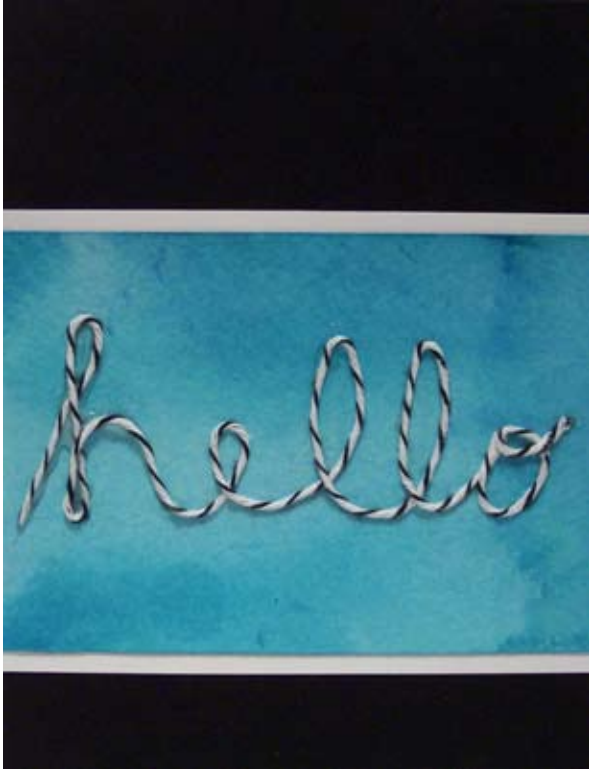
### Step Four:

Continue adding glue and twine to each letter as outlined in Steps Two and Three.

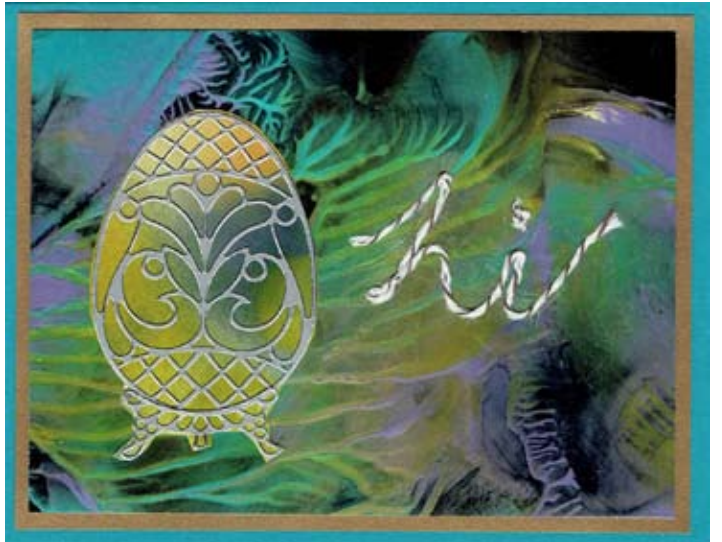
