

## Waxy Window Tutorial

*This is just yummy! It's a combination of the Waxy Cuttlebug Technique and Die Cut Windows -- all on one layer! Filmed by Beth Norman.*

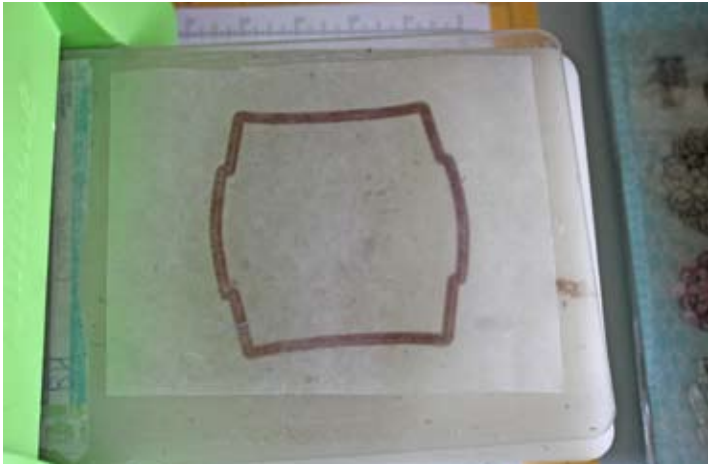
### Finished Card:

Artist: Beth Norman  
Stamps: Verve Stamps



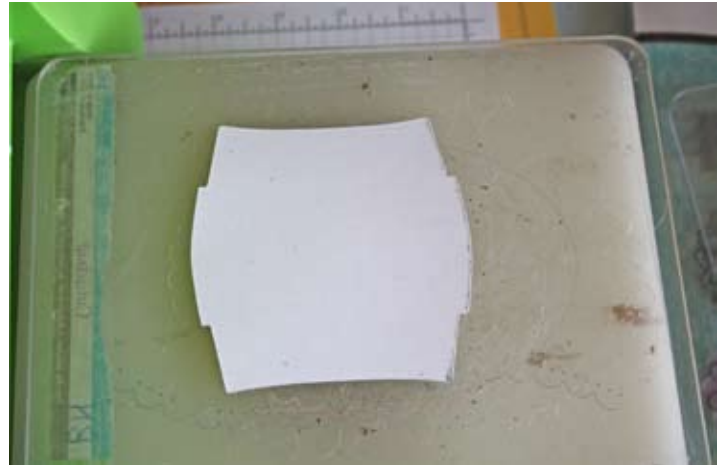
### Supplies:

- Wax Paper
- Die Cut
- White or Light Cardstock
- Copy Paper, larger than project size
- Scrap Copy Paper or Scrap Cardstock
- Kaleidacolor Ink Pad
- Brayer
- Stamp(s) (smaller than die cut)
- Embossing Folder
- Iron (not in photo)
- Embossing/Die Cutting Machine (not in photo)
- Removable Adhesive (not in photo)



### Step One:

Cut the wax paper to slightly larger than project size. Use die to cut a “window” in the wax paper.



### Step Two:

Cut the same shape out of the scrap copy paper/cardstock.



### Step Three:

Place wax paper into embossing folder and emboss.



### Step Four:

Place the wax paper over the base cardstock, positioning the window on the wax paper as desired for the final piece. Place the die cut from Step Two over the window.



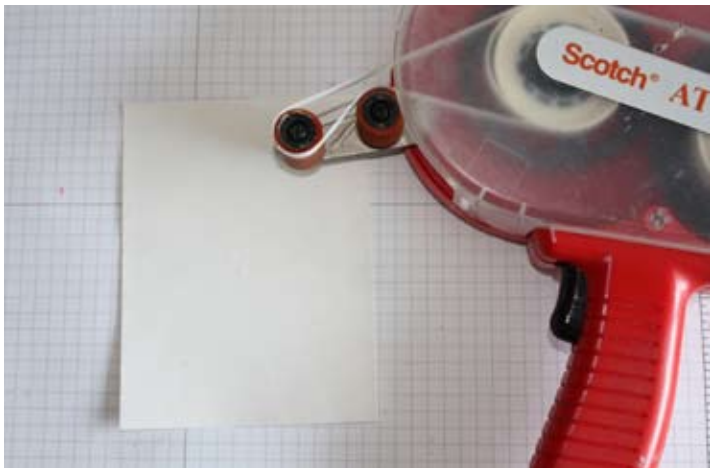
### Step Five:

Cover the piece with the copy paper.



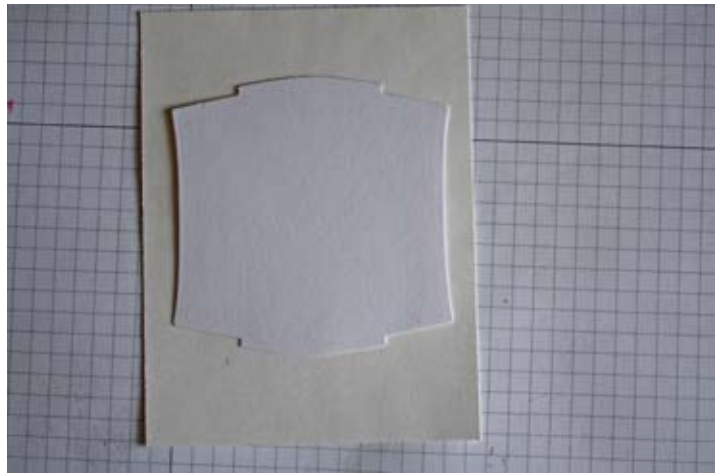
### Step Six:

Using medium heat, iron over top of the cardstock.



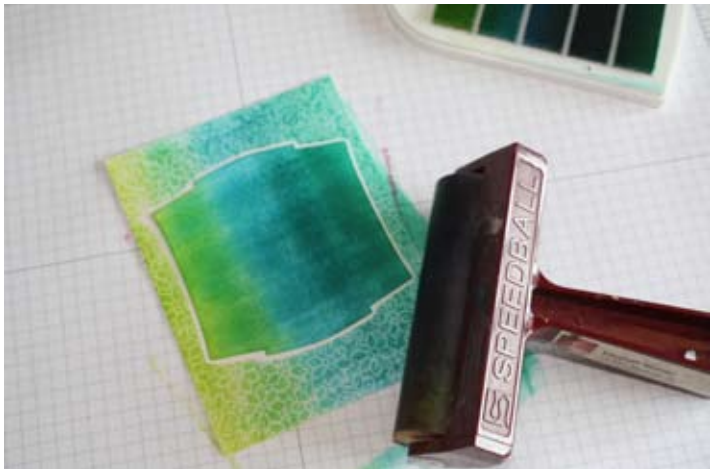
### Step Seven:

Place a small piece of removable adhesive in the centre of area that has been covered by the scrap die cut piece.



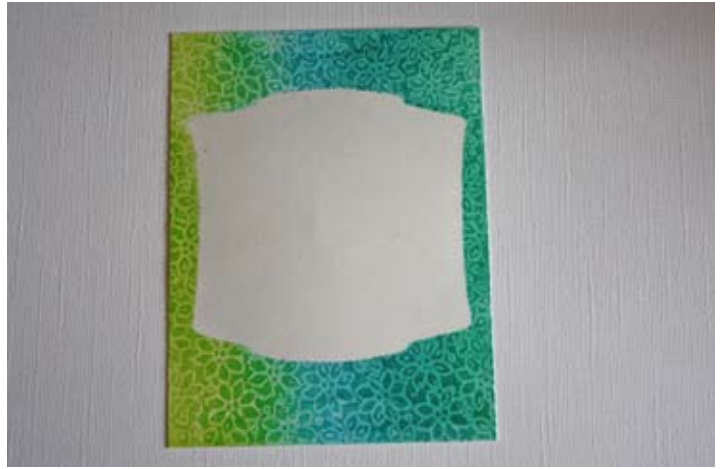
### Step Eight:

Place scrap die cut over top, carefully aligning the area that wasn't embossed.



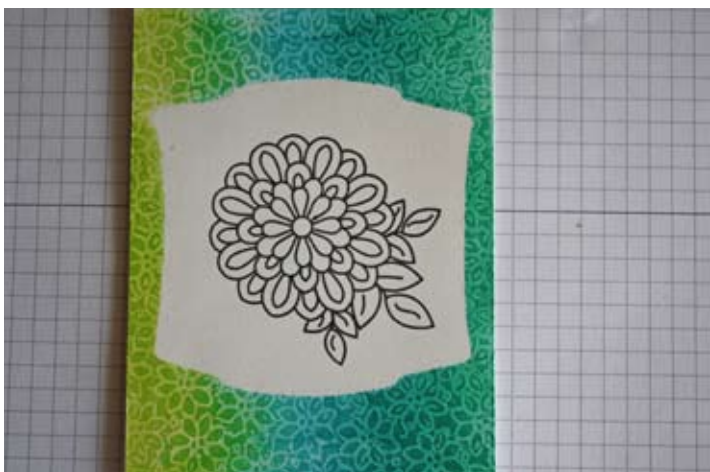
### Step Nine:

Brayer the rainbow ink over the piece, going over it several times to get good coverage.



### Step Ten:

Remove the die cut piece.



### Step Eleven:

Stamp the image in the center of the window and finish card as desired.

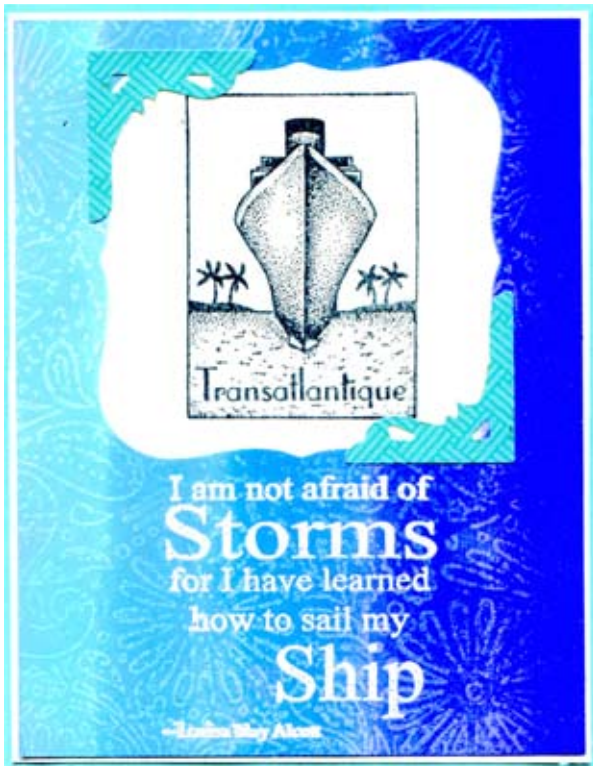
