

## Crinkled Watercolors Tutorial

*You can use very inexpensive watercolor paints for this easy technique. Unlike other crinkle techniques, this one is ready in just a few minutes! Filmed by Pat Huntoon.*

### Finished Card:

Artist: Pat Huntoon

Stamps: Technique Junkies Stamps



### Supplies:

- Watercolor Paper
- 3 Watercolor Paint Tubes
- Paint Palette
- Gift Tissue Paper
- Water
- Paintbrush



### Step One:

Squeeze a dollop of watercolor from each tube into a separate well in the palette.



### Step Two:

Add a bit of water to each color. Stir the colors with the paintbrush to mix the paint and water.



### Step Three:

Use the paintbrush to add a light wash of color and water over the watercolor paper.



### Step Four:

Load the paintbrush with the lightest color and apply to the paper randomly, leaving space for the other colors.



### Step Five:

Apply the other two colors in the same manner until the paper is covered with intense color.



### Step Six:

Trim off a piece of gift tissue to be slightly larger than watercolor paper. Ball up the tissue to create wrinkles.





### Step Seven:

Press the tissue paper onto the wet watercolor without smoothing the wrinkles out completely.



### Step Nine:

Gently remove the tissue paper.



### Step Eleven:

Allow the piece to dry and use as desired. The piece can be stamped over or used as a background.



### Step Eight:

Set the piece aside to set for 2 - 3 minutes.



### Step Ten:

Set aside the tissue paper for use in other projects, such as the Tissued Watercolor Technique in the June/July issue of the Technique Junkie Newsletter.

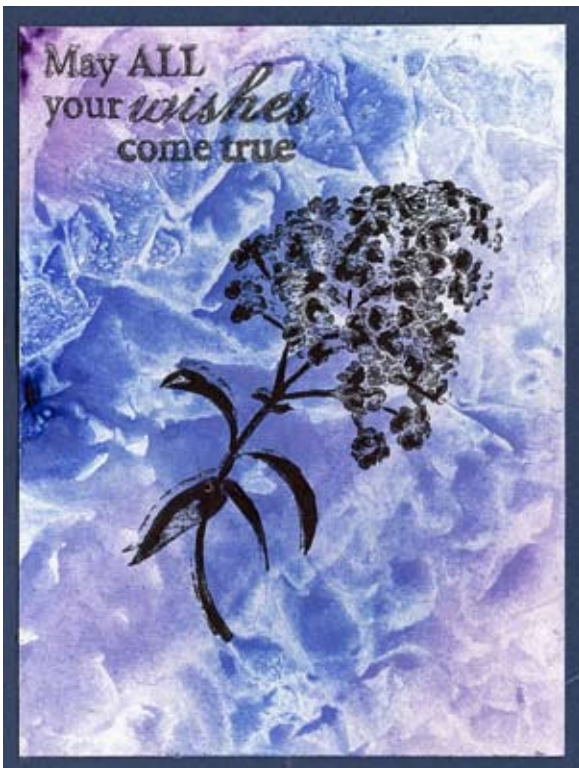
