

## Reverse Washi Window Tutorial

*Washi Tape makes a quick, easy and colorful background for highlighting your favorite stamps. Filmed by Pat Huntoon.*

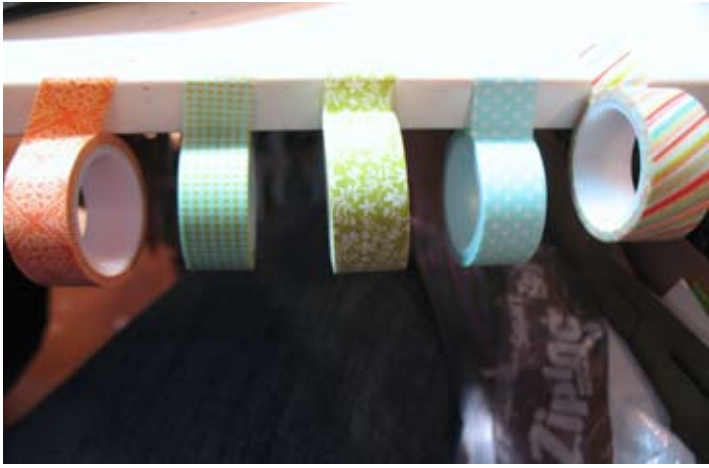
### Finished Card:

Artist: Pat Huntoon  
Stamps: Stampin' Up!

### Supplies:

- White, Vanilla or Neutral Cardstock
- Matting Cardstock (not pictured)
- White, Vanilla or Neutral Base Cardstock
- Die Cut with Machine
- Stamp that is slightly smaller than die
- Several Rolls of Washi Tape
- Scissors
- Ink
- Coloring Tools
- Pop-Dots/Dimensionals
- Optional: Stamp Positioner
- Pencil and Eraser



### Step One:

Optional: To manage the tape easily, adhere the edge of the Washi tape to the edge of your work surface, hanging the tape off the edge.



### Step Three:

Adhere different Washi tapes in strips above the first line.



### Step Five:

Fold the edges of the Washi tape over the edge of the cardstock, or trim of excess with scissors or trimmer.



### Step Two:

Apply one of the tapes to the bottom edge of the cardstock.



### Step Four:

Fill the piece completely with Washi Tape.



### Step Five Continued





### Step Six:

Mat the Washi tape-covered piece onto the matting cardstock.



### Step Seven:

Use the die and die cut to create a window from the Washi Tape piece.



### Step Seven Continued



### Step Eight:

Place the die cut piece over the card base in desired position.



### Step Nine:

Trace lightly around the die cut shape onto the base cardstock.



### Step Ten:

Use the stamp positioner to place the stamp in the desired position.



### Step Eleven:

Stamp the image.



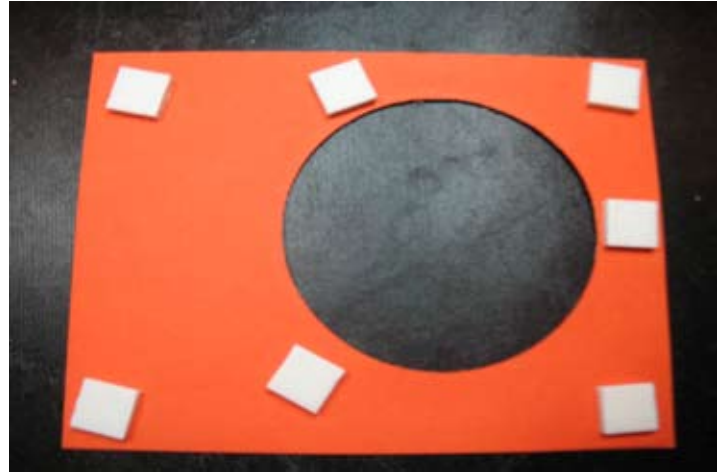
### Step Twelve:

Erase the pencil lines.



### Step Thirteen:

Color the image.



### Step Fourteen:

Place pop dots on the back of the die cut piece.



### Step Fifteen:

Adhere to the base cardstock and use as desired.
