



Distress Dragging Tutorial

This is another of the Ranger Techniques that Sally Lynn MacDonald taught me. This has a similar look to the Chalk Dragging Technique (from our first year of publishing), this is a lovely - and easy - background that uses the intensity of Distress Inks.



Supplies:

- 3 Distress Inks in Complementary Colors
- 3 Small Pieces of Ranger's Cut and Dry Pad
- Light-Colored Ultra-Smooth Cardstock
- Scrap with roughly torn edge, slightly larger than cardstock



Step One:

Pick up one of the inks with one of the cut and dry pieces.



Step Two:

Place the torn edge over the smooth cardstock, with approximately 1/2" of the cardstock showing. Starting on the edge of the scrap, push the pad away from the edge onto the smooth cardstock. Continue along the entire torn edge.



Step Three:

Move the torn scrap back to expose another 1/2" of cardstock. Use the same ink application process to apply ink to the exposed area.



Step Four:

Repeat steps one and two until approximately 1/3 of the cardstock is covered.



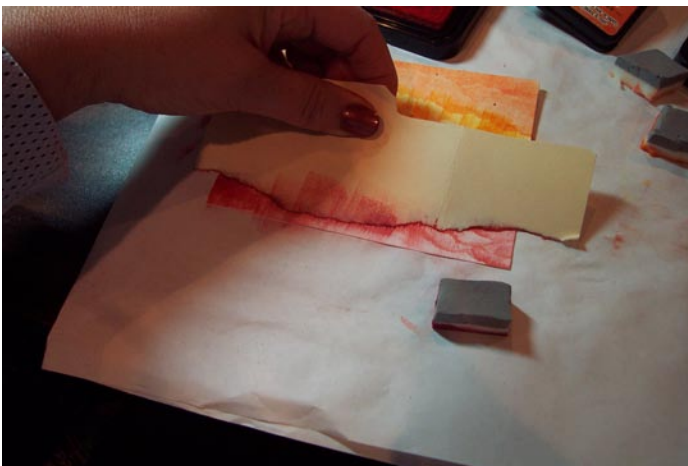
Step Five:

Using a fresh Cut and Dry pad, pick up the next color of ink, and apply the second color using steps two and three, covering the second third of the cardstock.



Step Six:

Repeat with the remaining color until 1/2" or less of the cardstock remains.



Step Seven:

Using the last color on the pad, gently fill in the remainder of the cardstock.



Step Eight:

Finish card as desired.

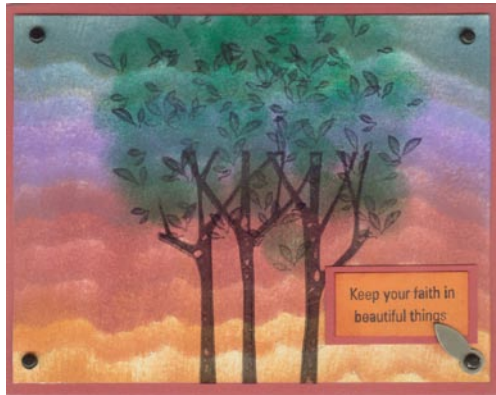
