## Background Pop Tutorial

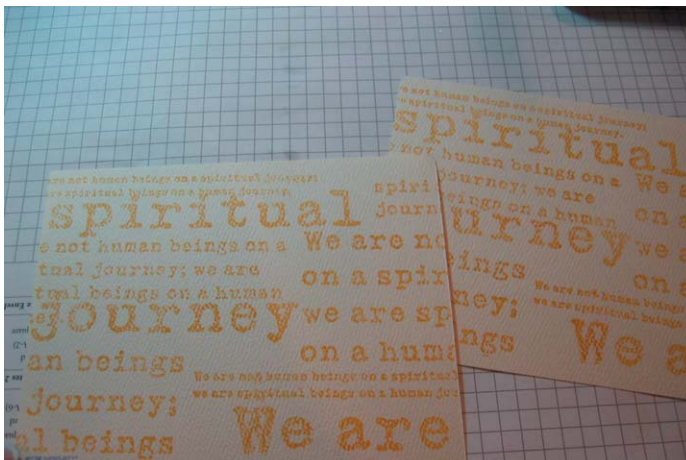

*Suggested by Technique Junkie Cathy Green, this quick and easy technique uses a combination of background and foreground images to create a dimensional look. For best results, the foreground image should be approximately 1/3 of the size of the background stamp.*



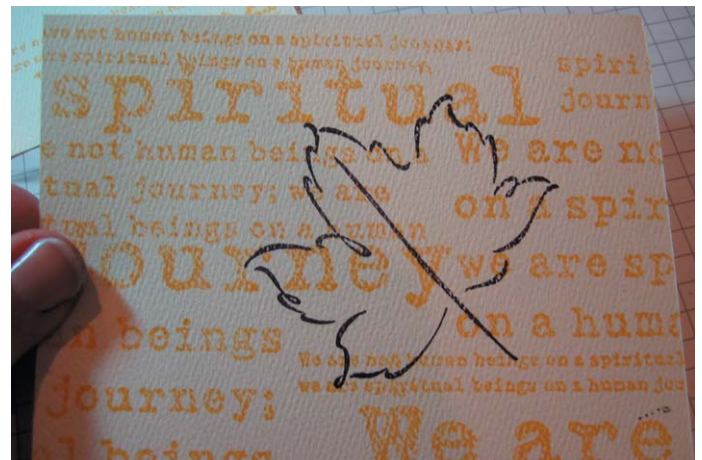
### Supplies:

- Background Stamp with Strong Images
- Smaller Foreground Stamp with Open Inside Image
- Dark or Black Ink
- Ink in Lighter Color (any color)
- 2 Pieces of Identical A-2 Cardstock
- Scissors
- Dimensional Pop-Dots



### Step One:

Stamp the background stamp on the two identical pieces of cardstock.



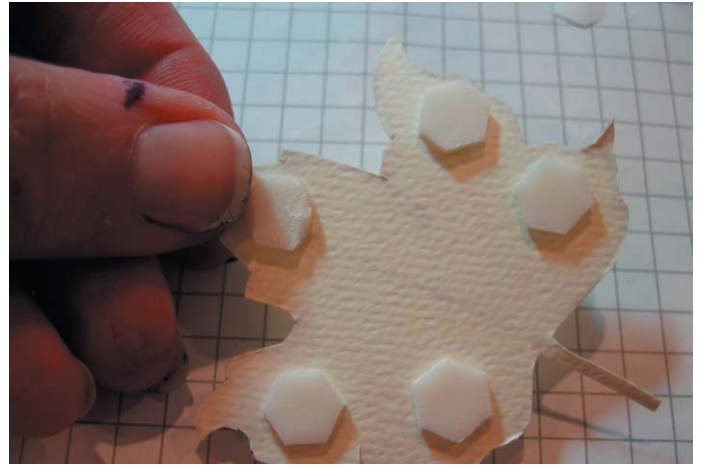
### Step Two:

Using dark ink, stamp foreground stamp onto one piece of the cardstock in the position where you desire the image to "pop".



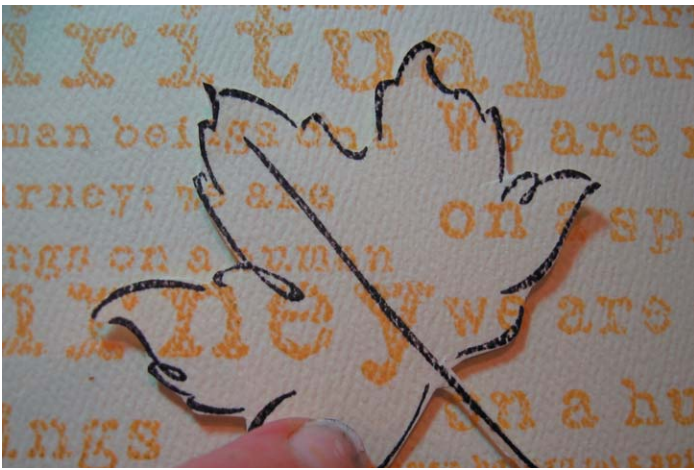
### Step Three:

Use scissors to cut out the stamped image.



### Step Four:

Apply pop dots to the back side of the cut image.



### Steps Five and Six:

Adhere the stamped image on the other background sheet, aligning the cut-out so that the background image flows with the top image.

Mat and embellish as desired.

*Note: To add further dimension to the top pieces, add chalk or ink to the edges.*

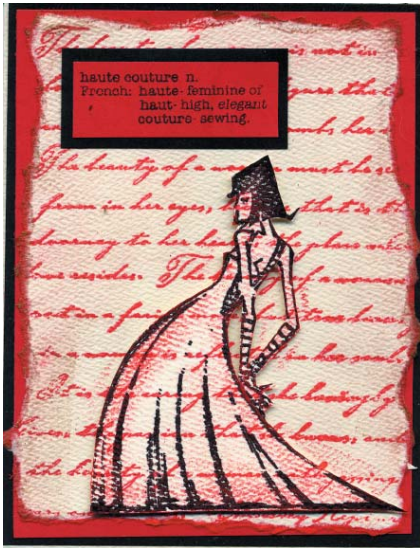

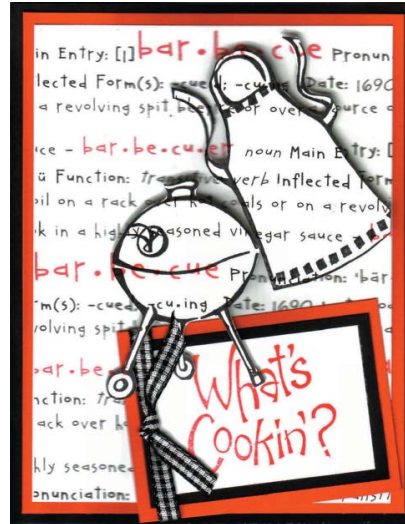
