

The Patstamps TECHNIQUE JUNKIE NEWSLETTER

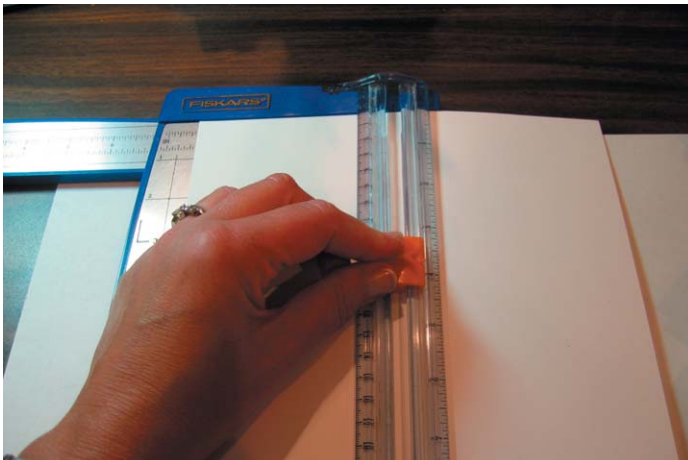
Spectrum Roll Tutorial August/September 2005

Gerrie Johnnic contributed this great technique. The fun part of this technique is that you will have several pieces of sparkly, colorful cardstock, with different color variations, in a snap!



Supplies:

- Rainbow, Kaliedacolor, or Spectrum Pad
- Marvy Metallic Markers
- Water in a Spritzer Bottle
- Smooth Cardstock
- Rubber Brayer
- Trimmer
- Temporary Adhesive



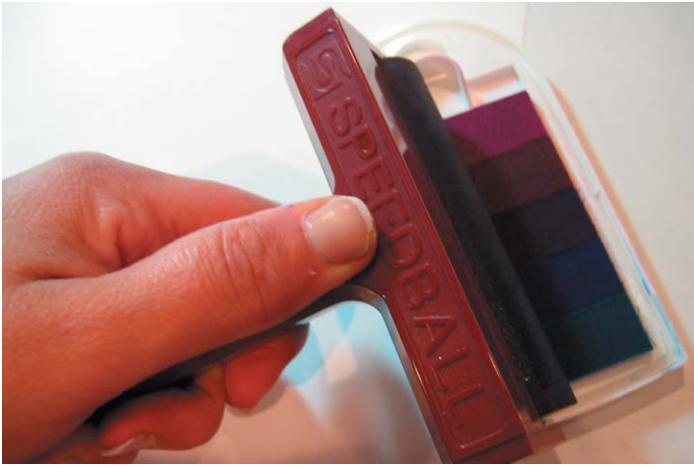
Step One:

Cut the cardstock in half at the 4-1/4" mark (the "long" way).



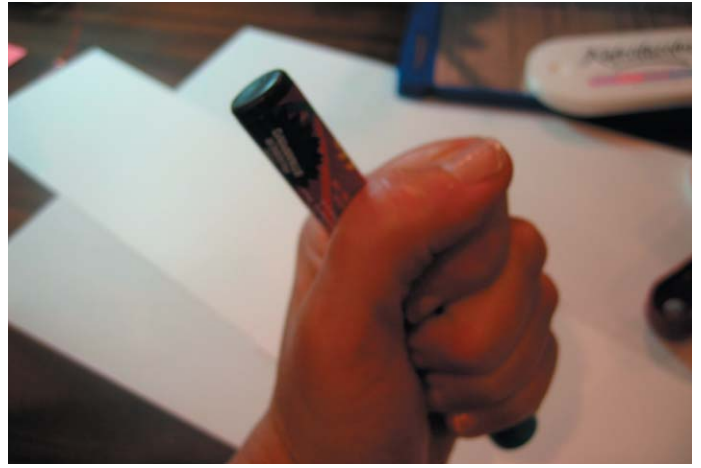
Step Two:

Using temporary adhesive, adhere the two pieces of paper together so that you have one long sheet. Turn adhesive to the back, and place on the cardstock on a clean surface.



Step Three:

Ink the brayer with rainbow ink, getting as much ink on the brayer as possible.



Step Four:

Shake the metallic markers vigorously.



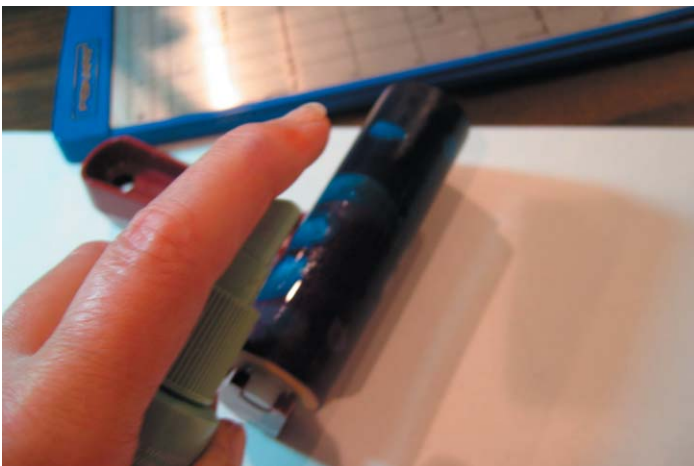
Step Five:

Dot the metallic marker directly on the brayer.



Step Six:

Repeat with any other metallic markers.



Step Seven:

Spritz brayer with water.



Step Eight:

In one smooth stroke, without lifting or stopping, roll the brayer from the bottom of the long cardstock piece to the top.



Step Nine:

Allow to dry, cut to size, and use as desired. Piece can be used as a background, or stamped on directly.

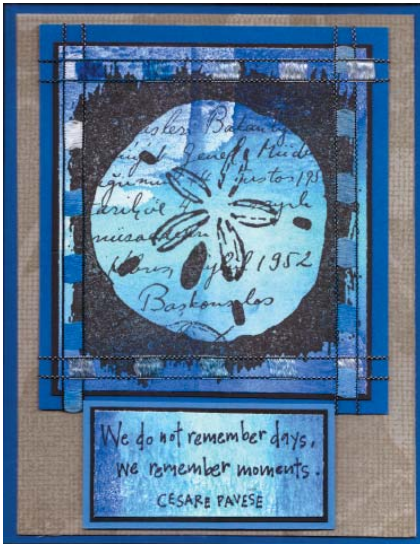

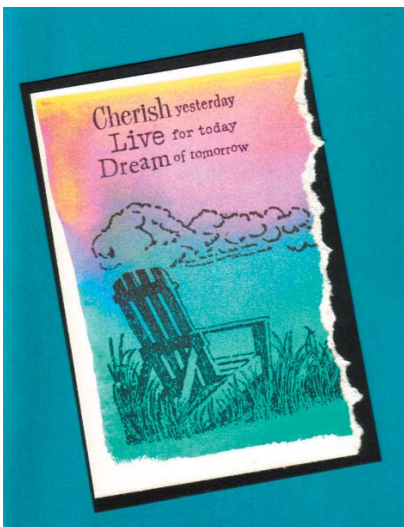

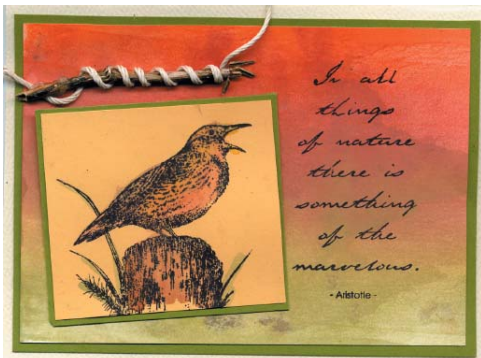
