Supplies:

- 2 - 3 colors of Opalite Reinkers
- Black or Dark Cardstock
- Stiff Cardstock Scrap or Old Credit Card



Step One:

Squirt reinker color on dark cardstock.



Step Two:

Add reinker colors (three are used here) leaving space between colors.



Step Three:

Use credit card or stiff piece of cardstock to move inks around black cardstock. Long, full strokes, pulling the reinker colors, seem to work well.



Step Four:

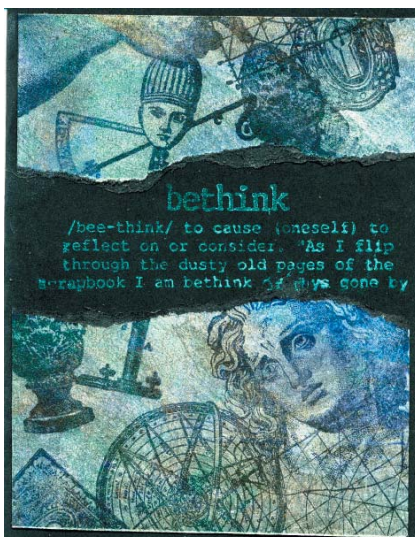
If desired, add more reinker in areas where the reinkers did not cover, and spread again with cardstock.



Step Five:

Allow to dry. Can be used as a background piece or it can be stamped on directly.

NOTE: It can be tricky to attach items to the opalite cardstock -- I found that I needed eyelets (brads, etc) to keep things secure on the opalite surface.

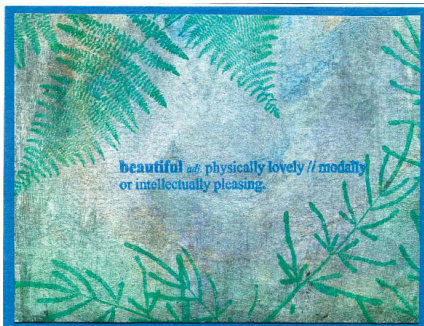
