Supplies:

- Large Image Stamp
- Coloring Tools (if necessary)
- Black Ink Pad
- Black Marker
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Exacto Knife
- Scissors
- Cutting Mat
- White Cardstock
- Cardstock for Matting



Step One:

Stamp the image on white cardstock.



Step Two:

Color image if desired/necessary.



Step Three:
Using pencil and ruler, mark a "box" around image, allowing small sections of 1/4" to 1/2" of the image to overlap the "box". Do not place pencil lines on the image itself.




Step Three Continued:



Step Five:
Using scissors, cut around silhouetted sections of the image that ore "outside the box."

Step Four:
Use Exacto knife to cut pencil lines (do not cut into image).Remove excess paper.



Step Five Continued:



Step Six:
Use black marker on edges of box on straight portion of piece.



Step Seven & Eight: Mount on cardstock, making mat slightly larger than the image "box" (allowing the silhouetted image to overlap


Mount and embellish as desired.

matted cardstock).








